Have you ever walked a labyrinth?

I have found spiritual inspiration in doing so, especially in some very interesting places. In Alaska, we found a labyrinth at a retreat house on the shore. Facing East there were stately evergreens and mountains, and facing west there was water as far as the eye could see. The tranquility solicited voice from nature, whispering, you are part of the whole of nature, the wonderful gift of the Creator. In South Africa in the courtyard of St. Georges Cathedral where Bishop Tutu was resident, I walked toward the center, asking prayerfully where and when have I experienced the grace and love of God? Walking out, I prayed, where and when have I shared the love of God with others? Used as an icon of the faith journey, a labyrinth is an ancient tradition of prayer, discernment, and formation. The vision of Beloved Community embraced by the Episcopal Church in 2017 “rises from a commitment to following the Bible’s most important commandments: to love God and love our neighbors, in whom we see the face of God. Beloved Community is the community that loves as God intends: where truth is told and hierarchies of human value are dismantled, where each person and culture is protected and honored as an equally beloved part of the human family of God, and where we counter human selfishness – the true root of sin and racism – with the selfless love of Jesus.” (www.episcopalchurch.org/beloved-community).

TRINITY COOKIE RECIPE

Here is a recipe that the children at HTC Cooking Camp enjoyed making this year. Note, they are called Trinity Cookies because they are made with three ingredients in honor of God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit!

- 1 cup peanut butter
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 egg

1. Mix three ingredients then drop by teaspoons full on parchment lined cookie sheet.
